Angie Sexton, RN DIP ENB 998, completed her training in Salford in 1993 gaining a diploma in professional nursing studies. She went on to obtain her ENB 998 (Teaching in Clinical Practice), her P.A.C.E. accreditation with Northamptonshire Social Services and became a POVA trainer with Telford and Wrekin Local Authority.

Angie Sexton has over 15 years experience in the NHS, Social Services, and Independent Sector working with a diverse range of client groups including, elderly care, general medicine and vulnerable adults with learning disabilities and mental health needs

She has also worked with the following client groups, stroke, cardiac, orthopaedics, oncology, brain injury and complex care needs.

Over the last 10 years, Angie Sexton has been involved in Case Management, in various areas including vulnerable adults with learning disabilities and behavioural problems. She has also undergone extensive training in relation to sexually challenging behaviour and sexually offending behaviour.

During this time, Angie Sexton also worked in Case Management for adolescents transitioning into Adult Care Management, ages ranging from 15 -18 years.

In addition to this Angie Sexton was involved as a Branch Manager and later a regional Support Manager with Care UK in domiciliary care particularly for clients suffering from neurological disorders such as Multiple Sclerosis and Motor Neuron Disease.

This involved the rehabilitation assessment for clients who have experienced traumatic injuries or events, e.g. orthopaedic trauma, brain injury and psychiatric illness.

Angie Sexton has worked as Manager setting up a nursing and care agency, which included developing links with Trans House in Oswestry which provides a transitional rehabilitation service for people with spinal injuries.

For the last four years Angie Sexton been working as Vocational Rehabilitation Case Manager, with responsibility for managing Vocational issues for clients who are absent from work as a result of mental health related illnesses, catastrophic injuries and major orthopaedic injuries. She has gained experience in assessing the Vocational needs for clients and exploring their return to work options.
