

## Christopher Wynne, Physiotherapist

Christopher Wynne, BSc (Hons), MCSP, is a rehabilitation physiotherapist with specialist expertise in neurology. He is a member of the Chartered Society of Physiotherapy and is registered with the Health Professions Council. He is a member of the Association of Chartered Physiotherapists in Neurology, the Medico-Legal Association of Chartered Physiotherapists, the United Kingdom Acquired Brain Injury Forum, the Multiple Sclerosis Society professional network and The Parkinson's UK professional network.

Christopher Wynne is the Lead Physiotherapist at his private practice, The Rehab Physio. He is highly successful in providing rehabilitation for individuals with complex needs, including those with Strokes, Acquired Brain Injury, Spinal Injuries and Orthopaedic Injury. His approach focuses on postural correction to increase the efficiency of an individual's physical function.

In conjunction with this, he is a Senior Physiotherapist at the Wirral University Teaching Hospital NHS Foundation Trust, providing intervention in a variety of areas, including the nationally recognised Stroke Rehabilitation Unit.

Christopher regularly acts as a mentor to undergraduate, preceptorship level and assistant physiotherapists. He runs educational workshops in postural control, neuroplasticity and rehabilitation skills. He presents this to a wide variety of different professional groups, non-professionals and informal carers.

Christopher has extensive experience in rehabilitating those with neurological conditions and neuro-musculoskeletal disorders and has a large depth of postgraduate education in this field.

In his previous role, he was Lead Physiotherapist, at a newly opened private rehabilitation unit in Chester. He developed all the physiotherapy services from inception, devising new pathways and good practice guidelines based on the best evidence.

These services include hydrotherapy, neurophysiotherapy in-patient, out-patient and domiciliary services. Prior to this, he developed his post graduate experience as a Senior Physiotherapist at the Wirral University Teaching Hospital.

At the Wirral University Teaching Hospital, he gained much experience in a variety of areas such as orthopaedic rehabilitation, intensive care and acute rehabilitation. The latter years of this period were spent, working in a specialist capacity, exclusively in neurology.

In addition, Christopher is trained in the delivery of Botulinum Toxin, Functional Electrical Stimulation and Aquatic therapy. He has close links with Rehabilitation Consultants and other specialist neurological professionals.

Christopher has combined his work for his private practice with maintaining a senior role in the NHS, enabling him to have a greater insight into the long term rehabilitation needs of patients with neurological and orthopaedic disability.

His close links to the commercial sector ensure he has an accurate knowledge of the availability and costing of provisions. Christopher is flexible when attending meetings and always meets deadlines.
