

## Lisa Green, Occupational Therapist

Lisa Green (Dip COT) is an experienced Occupational Therapist having qualified from the University of Derby in 1993. She is registered with the Health Professions Council and is a member of the British Association of Occupational Therapists. Lisa has worked in the NHS and Social Services gaining extensive experience of working with adults and children with highly complex disabilities.

Upon qualifying as an OT, Lisa's first rotational post was in the NHS in Leicestershire gaining hospital experience in rehabilitation within Health Care of the Elderly. In 1994 her second rotation was in Acute Psychiatry followed by Forensic Psychiatry where she secured a promotion and remained within this clinical area until 1997.

Lisa then moved to work in Nottingham for the City Council's Social Services Department. For 11 years she worked within an Adult Services Team gaining a vast amount of experience of assessing clients with a wide variety of disabilities including MS, Huntington's disease, Motor Neurone Disease, Amputation, Orthopaedic conditions and Spinal Injury. Her work involved recommending specialised equipment

solutions, including bespoke items, and complex structural adaptation work. Part of her role also included identifying the need for re-housing and ensuring the new property met the needs of the individual and their family. This work

also involved moving and handling and liaising with other statutory organisations and departments in health, the local authority and education as well as voluntary organisations where necessary to benefit her clients.

During this time, Lisa was seconded on three separate occasions to broaden her clinical skills and knowledge base. Firstly in 2002 she was seconded for 16 months into Nottingham City Council's Housing Department as a Disability Housing Advisor. Her role included:

- Identifying appropriate council properties for adults and children registered on the Council's re-housing list
- Ensuring best use of Council Housing stock
- Liaising with Housing Associations in developing new build projects within the City of Nottingham appropriate for residents with a disability
- Providing disability expertise to adaptations officers



In 2003 Lisa was seconded as a Temporary OT Team Manager for 14 months. She was responsible for managing a team of OT's and Community Care Officers, including front line supervision, and within this time she completed the ILM Level 3 Introductory Certificate in First Line Management.

In 2005 Lisa was seconded for 12 months to an NHS/Social Care integrated multi disciplinary Independent Living Team, working with clients with neurological conditions. Although her primary role was assessing for adaptations and equipment, she gained extensive experience of case managing clients receiving large packages of support including direct payments.

In 2008 Lisa left Adult Services and gained an OT post within Nottingham City Council's Disabled Children's Team. Casework involved assessing children 0-19 years old with a wide variety of disabilities including Cerebral Palsy, Autism, Learning Difficulties and Congenital abnormalities. In addition to recommending adaptations and equipment she had responsibility to assess for modular seating systems within the home environment and to provide reports for "Looked After" children regarding suitable care and respite placements.

In 2009 Lisa was promoted to Senior Practitioner within this team and in January 2011 was further promoted to a temporary position of Team Manager until June 2011. She had line responsibility for a team of Occupational Therapists and oversaw the OT duty point. Lisa was instrumental in developing the service area. This included recruitment, proposals for additional staff, reviewing the department's criteria and developing more effective policies and procedures for the OT staff within the team. Lisa joined Bush and Company in 2010 and has been regularly providing medico legal reports since, being instructed by both Claimant and Defendant Solicitors.
