

## Toby Beck, Social Worker

This includes situations where there is a significant childhood disability, areas of child protection concerns such as neglect or when there is a risk of sexual or physical abuse, parental violence or substance abuse.

Toby is able to plan and deliver case work schedules effectively and within required timescales. Toby has specialised in family and children services work; and this has included undertaking a range of assessments of need, including children and young people with a range of permanent and complex health needs and disabilities; court work and child protection work.

Toby has experience of working in the Voluntary and local Authority sectors, as a senior officer, Manager and Practice Teacher. Toby has recently led the project developments around the Aiming High agenda and transforming short breaks for disabled children in Nottingham City and as such has a sound understanding of Prince2 project management principles; he has also chaired various children in need and core group meetings and has skills in attending court both as a practitioner and as a Justice of the Peace.

Having undertaken a vocational route within Children and families services, over the last sixteen years and whilst studying Social Care on a continuous basis; Toby has had the opportunity to work within many multicultural environments, including managing a multi disciplined disabled children's service in the East Midlands area.

Toby has worked within local strategic partnerships, and has substantial experience and knowledge: of legislation and the issues pertinent to disabled children and their families; of allocating and managing casework; projects; task groups, and of supervising key personnel /staff.



Toby has also undertaken a range of reports in respect of adults, young people and children who might pose a sexual or violence risk to others. Toby is particularly interested in undertaking holistic assessments of children whom have complex needs due to either childhood or parental disability.

Toby utilises his extensive experience, knowledge and skills in his role as a Case Manager working with children, young people and their families who have experienced catastrophic injuries.
